



133RD PAISLEY ART INSTITUTE ANNUAL EXHIBITION

INFORMATION SHEET

During the renovation of Paisley Art Gallery and Museum, Paisley Art Institute will be utilising alternative venues for the Annual Exhibition. This year we will be located in the prestigious Glasgow Art Club, 185 Bath Street, Glasgow, G2 4HU. The exhibition will run from 28th October 2022 to 3rd December 2022. Further details on hand-in and collection times are below.

Due to space restrictions, this year, applications for wall-based entry are for members only. However, we are able to extend open entry for 3D Work.

WALL-BASED WORK

The maximum height or width of wall-based work should be 5½ feet. **Because this venue is not as large as our home venue some larger works may not be hung.**

Work should be suitably presented for the exhibition, no clip or metal frames. All works framed or unframed should be strong enough to hang.

Small works:

Only small works under 16x16 inches (total size framed or unframed) must be strung but please cover rings to avoid damaging other works.

3D WORK

The Glasgow Art Club is restricted from displaying free-standing sculpture as the venue is also used for corporate dinners and entertainment.

Sculptural work should be of a scale that will not create a health and safety issue when displayed on a plinth.

We do have a few plinths but if sculptors can supply their own plinth this would be to their advantage.

Plinths supplied by entrants will not be used with other work without the permission of the entrant.

LABELS AND DATA PROTECTION FORMS

All 3 sections of the labels should be completed and attached securely using string to the back of the work so that the label can hang down in front. This should be repeated for each artwork. **For additional security and identification, please ensure that the title, plus your name and contact details are written on the back of the work.** Data protection forms must be completed and delivered with your work. Please make sure that handwriting is clear and legible.

COURIER DELIVERY

As above but include a stamped, addressed envelope for the return of slips.

You can organise a personal uplift, delivery and return by contacting one of the couriers below.

Or you can take advantage of our collection points in Paisley and Edinburgh. A total of £10 each way will be charged for your submission.

Paisley Collection Point: Oakshaw Trinity Church, Oakshaw St East, Paisley, PA1 2DD

Pick up: Thursday 20th October 2022, 10 am -12 noon

Collection: Monday 5th December, 1pm -3pm

Beware of using Google Maps it will direct you to the Church's Administration address, ignore and go to the church carpark at the top of Oakshaw Hill.

Edinburgh Collection Point

The Mound EH2 2EL Thursday 20th October 2.30pm - 4.30pm

Please notify the Paisley Art Institute Secretary, in advance, if you wish to use the collection point service. You are responsible for getting your work to and from the collection point. If there is not enough demand for a collection point, we may have to cancel this service.

We would request that work is not sent in by standard post.
