

134th PAISLEY ART INSTITUTE OPEN ANNUAL EXHIBITION

INFORMATION SHEET

During the renovation of Paisley art Galleries/museum, the Paisley Art Institute will be utilising alternative venues for their Annual Exhibition. This year we will be in the prestigious Maclaurin Art Galleries, Rozelle Estate, Monument Road, Ayr KA7 4NQ. The exhibition will run from Saturday 20th May to Sunday 25th June 2023.

This will be an open PAI exhibition. Work should be original. NO copies.

WALL-BASED WORK

The maximum height or width of wall-based work should be within 5½ feet.

Work should be suitably presented for the exhibition, no clip or metal frames. All works framed or unframed should be strong enough to hang. All 2D works must arrive with D or O rings applied to the back, one third from the top.

Small works:

Only small works under 18x18 inches (overall size framed or unframed) must be strung. Please cover D and O rings to avoid damaging other works.

3D WORK

Sculptural work should be of a scale that will not create a health and safety issue when displayed.

We do have a few plinths but if sculptors can supply their own plinth this would be to their advantage.

Plinths supplied by entrants will not be used with other work without the permission of the entrant. Please clearly and discreetly mark your plinth with your name.

LABELS AND DATA PROTECTION FORMS

Important.

Submission information is required no later than the 20^{th of} April 2023. We are using on-line forms for submission.

Simply type in your information and send back. You will receive a confirmation email which is your label to print and attach to your work.

If last minute, and searching for your label in emails, search from, 'Google forms'

Labels should be completed and attached securely using string to the back of the work so that the label can hang down in front. This should be repeated for each artwork. For additional security and identification, please ensure that the title, plus your name and contact details are written on the back of the work.

COURIER DELIVERY

You can organise a personal uplift, delivery and return by contacting one of the couriers below. As this is a private arrangement you will have to pay direct the courier their quote.

Or you can take advantage of our collection points in Paisley and Edinburgh. A one-off payment of £30 Paisley to Ayr and £40 Edinburgh to Ayr, this includes return of work. Please notify membership@paisleyartinstitute.org of your interest.
